

Basketball Rule 2 Officials & Their Duties

Video Replay Equipment - not legal in Illinois

Jurisdiction - does not end until entire crew leaves the court; so

- A Coach can still get a technical foul after the horn has sounded & can be EJECTED for unsportsmanlike behavior
- All officials must be off the floor before jurisdiction has ended

Game Time Notification - if one team delays its return to the court at game time or half time by one minute, a technical foul is administered to the offending team. THIS IS A TEAM TECHNICAL and COACH DOES NOT LOSE HIS COACHING BOX ON TEAM TECHNICALS.

Disqualified Player becomes Bench Personnel when the Coach is notified. Therefore:

- If a disqualified player is issued a Technical Foul, this player is now considered BENCH PERSONNEL and the Coach is charged INDIRECTLY and loses his Coaching Box

Concussion Management- player has concussed symptoms must not re-enter the game without a health care professional's permission.

Rule 2 Section 10

Correctable Error - at the end of a quarter or half is still in the Correctable Error time frame
CORRECT THE ERROR

Correctable Error must be corrected no later than during the first dead ball after the clock has started.

If the ball is live during a 2 or 3 point shot, the error may be corrected up till the 2nd live ball.

If Coach requests a time out for a Correctable Error and is incorrect, he is charged with a 60 sec time out or 30 sec time out if he does not have a full time out left.

Remember the ball is dead after a good basket by definition.

Personal Fouls that occurred during correctable error are cancelled. However, if it is an Intentional or Flagrant, they are still enforced.

Correctable Errors - 4 of them have to do with Free Throw and must be recognized and corrected during the first dead ball after the clock has started. Any activity during a correctable error such as points scored or consumed time shall not be cancelled.

Unsporting, technical, intentional, activity shall not be cancelled

Changing a 2 point goal to a 3 point goal or a 3 point goal to a 2 point goal must be corrected before the 2nd live ball after the error.

The ball will be put back in play at the point of interruption.

A mistake in Scorekeeping may be corrected by an official with definite knowledge up to the approval of the final score.

Disqualified player must be replaced in 15 seconds after informing the Head Coach with a horn from the Timer immediately or the Coach will be charged with a Technical Foul & loss of Coaching Box.
